

Growing together, hand in hand

Educational goals:

- Independence (signing in and out after school care, light kitchen duties)
- Solidarity (showing consideration for others)
- Acceptance (diverse religious beliefs and cultures)
- Competency (in everyday situations, through play and exercise)
- Social skills (considerate behaviour towards others, dealing with conflict)
- Creativity
- Physical development (a healthy diet, physical activity indoors and out of doors)

Activities and projects:

- In the various group rooms, quiet areas and creative spaces
- Out of doors through free play and dynamic games
- Specific activities, e.g. excursions or playground visits, particularly as part of the holiday care programme

After school care team:

Consists of 20 members of staff and one manager (supported by the school janitor and school secretary). Their diverse skills and perceptions allow your children to benefit from a wide range of experiences, which is reflected in our key objective.

Daily schedule:

11.20	After school care begins (children sign in with the relevant caregiver!)
11.45-14.00	After signing in, the children have lunch accompanied by two caregivers / free play or arts and crafts for the remaining children
13:00-15:00	Homework supervision from Monday to Thursday (in cooperation with teachers, caregivers and external helpers) / games and activities for those children who have already finished their homework
14.00	Children in care group I go home / are picked up (sign out with the relevant caregiver!)
15.00	Games and activities / prebooked extracurricular activities offered by the school / children in care group II go home
16.00	Small snack (fruit) for those children still in after school care / children in care group III go home
17.00	After school care programme ends

After school care should be fun for everyone – please help us to achieve this!

1. **Please tell the caregiver in person when you pick up your child from school.**
2. **Please notify us in good time (either in writing - particularly if your child will be walking home alone - or orally) if you are unable to pick up your child or if someone else is going to pick up your child.**
3. **Please ensure that your child knows that he or she must not leave the school grounds without the permission of a caregiver.**
4. **Please let us know if your child is taking any medication / has any allergies.**
5. **Children should be picked up on time from after school care, or go home by themselves, since there is no insurance cover once the relevant care module has come to an end!**

Holiday care programme:

Various play and arts and crafts activities and excursions are offered as part of the holiday care programme. The programme is geared towards the relevant group of children and their particular holiday requirements.

Caterer:

Service Gesellschaft der Kliniken des Main-Taunus Kreises GmbH serves as our caterer. Parents must sign a separate agreement with the catering firm. Application forms can be obtained from the after school care team or the school secretary. If you have signed your child up for the basic care package (pickup by 14.00) then school dinners are **optional**; lunch is **compulsory** for children in care groups I-III (15.00, 16.00 or 17.00 pickup).
